Introducing to Woocommerce Buy Button.


The Woocommerce flexible add to cart Plugin is an indispensable tool to help you add a "buy now", "add to cart", ...button and move people directly to the cart after they click it:

Configuration

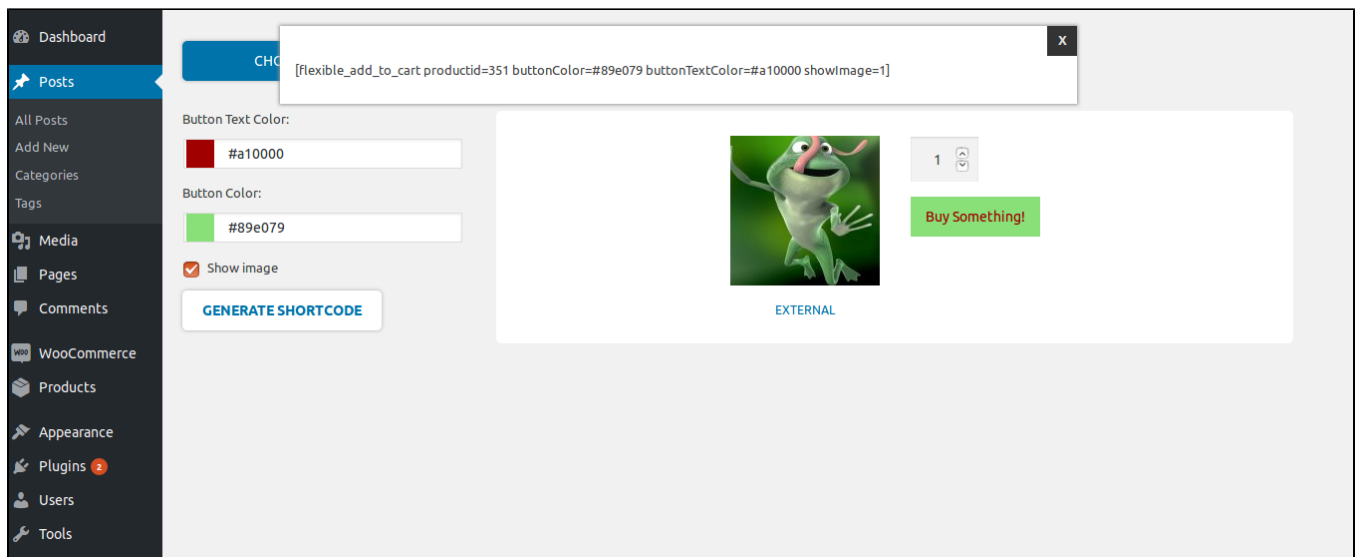
You can access configuration page by click **Buy Button**.

Add shortcode into posts and pages

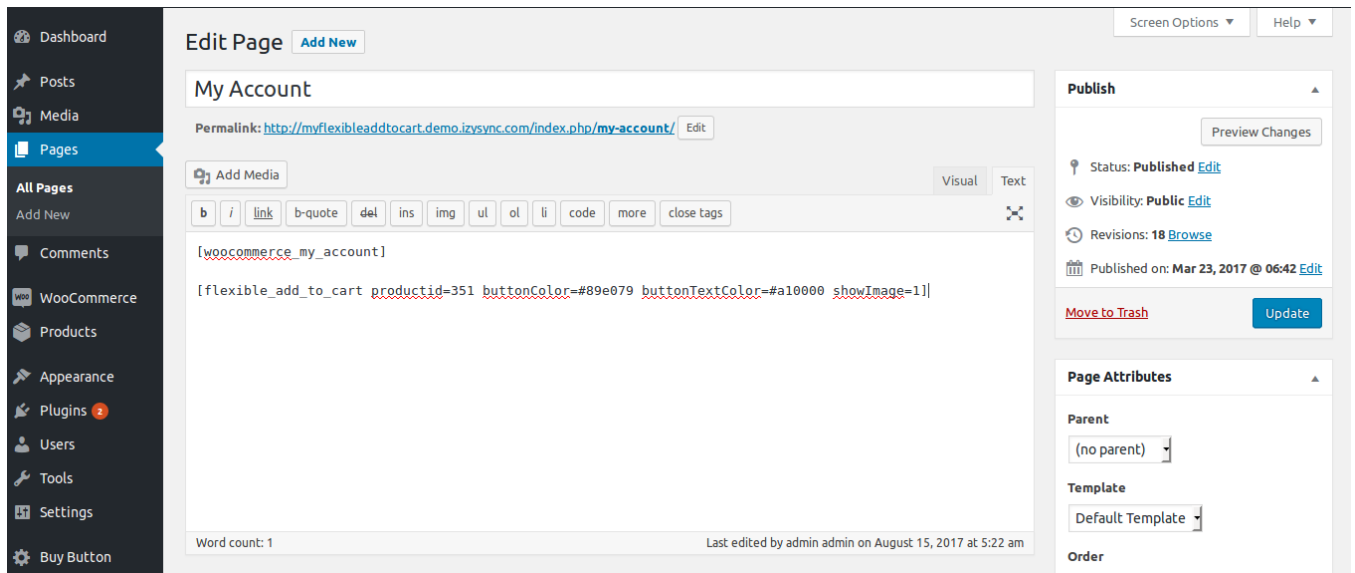
Then click **GENERATE SHORTCODE**, you get a shortcode:
